Does my organization participate in one of the programs listed here?

Office of Community Planning and Development (CPD) Programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR), Continuum of Care (CoC), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA), Housing Trust Fund (HTF), Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP), Rural Housing Stability Assistance

What housing services does my organization provide by requirement, funding, or referral?

- My program and/or the grantee require us to provide housing counseling services that meet the definition of housing counseling as defined at CFR Part 5.100¹
- My program makes referrals to housing counseling services that meet the definition of housing counseling as defined at CFR Part 5.100¹
- My program funds housing counseling services that meet the definition of housing counseling as defined at CFR Part 5.100¹

Exception: My program provides housing counseling in the context of holistic case management under the CoC, ESG, or HOPWA Programs.

- Become a HUD-approved Housing Counseling Agency (HCA)
- Partner with or make referrals to a HUD-approved HCA with HUD certified housing counselors

The housing services that we provide do not meet the definition of housing counseling per CFR part 5.100¹, such as:

- Housing information, or placement or referral services
- Routine administrative activities (such as program eligibility determination and intake)
- Case management that is incidental to a larger case management and does not fund housing counseling
- Fair housing advice and advocacy, such as processing complaints and filing claims
- Group education without individualize housing counseling services
